

Combining floor-level functionality with increased height for caregiving

Less frequent falls and injuries

Lowering to just 7cm, the FloorBed 2 helps prevent falls and associated injuries.






A safer working height

A nursing height of 80cm combined with the low head and footboards offers a safer working height for caregivers and easier access for care tasks and repositioning.

Floor level minimises fall velocity and impact force

Bed height is a significant contributor to fall related injuries.¹² Evidence suggests a floor-level bed of 100 mm or less from the floor* is optimum in reducing the risk of injury associated with a bed fall.



Optional extras to complement the FloorBed 2



Integrated padded side rails

Soft fabric side rails for added protection.



Head and foot board bumpers

Soft bumpers to cushion impact.



2200 mm High safety mat

Same height as the mattress - a fall becomes a roll.



Safety sleeve

Reduces risk of entrapment as the platform mechanism is protected.



Bed lever

Enables independent movement.



Lifting pole

Assists with bed mobility and transfers.



Mattress infill

Reduces the gap between the mattress and side rails.



Bed extension kit

Increases mattress platform length to 2200 mm.



Junior Kit

Compatible with FloorBed 1 & 2.
